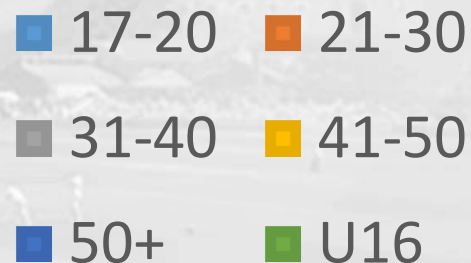
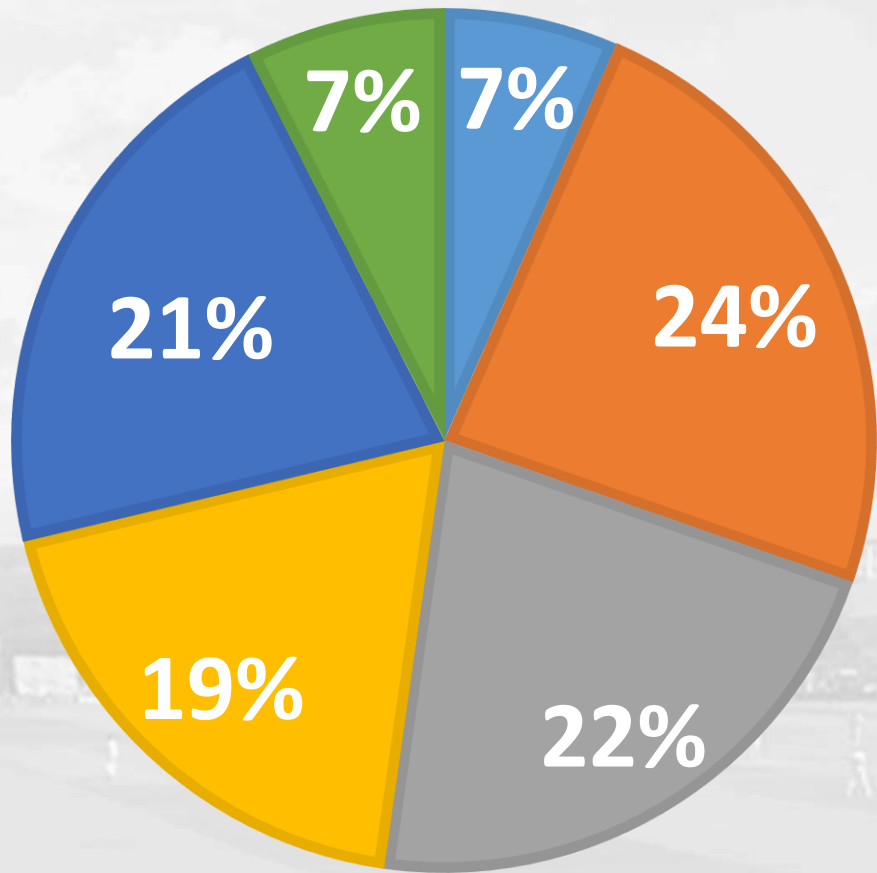


DCF Open Age Cricket Survey

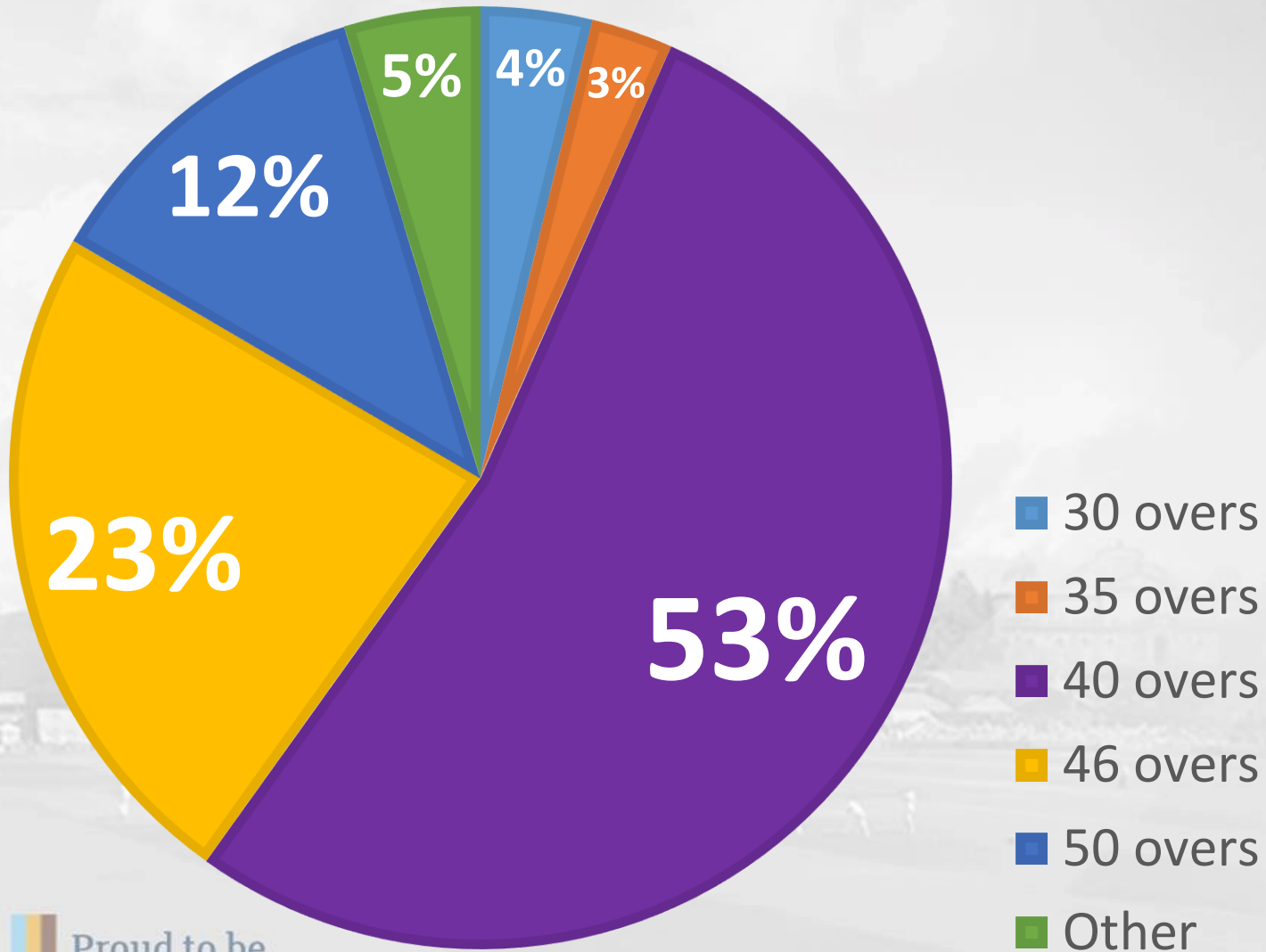
Age of Respondents

Preferred Number of Overs

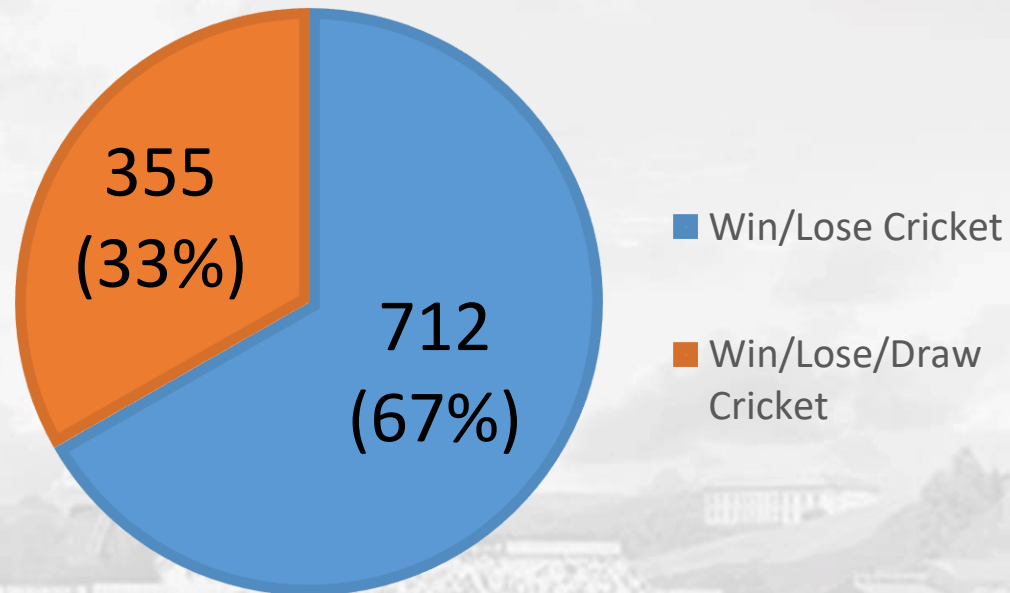

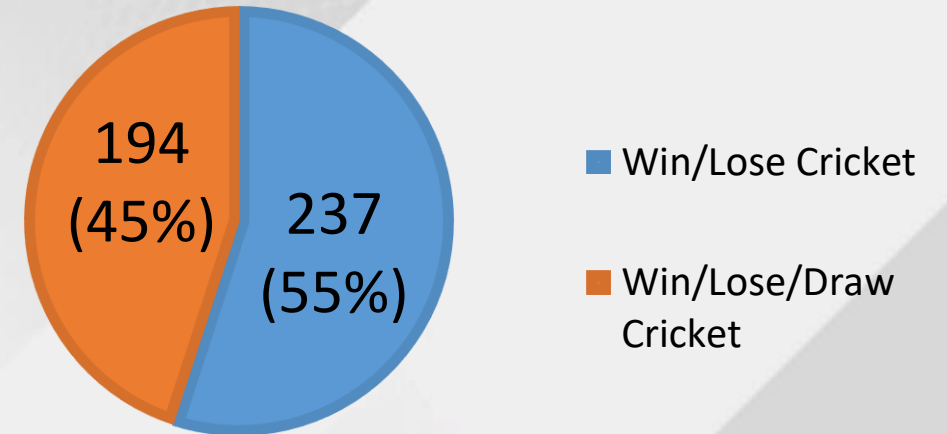
- More votes for 40 overs than for all other innings lengths combined

Preferred Type of Cricket

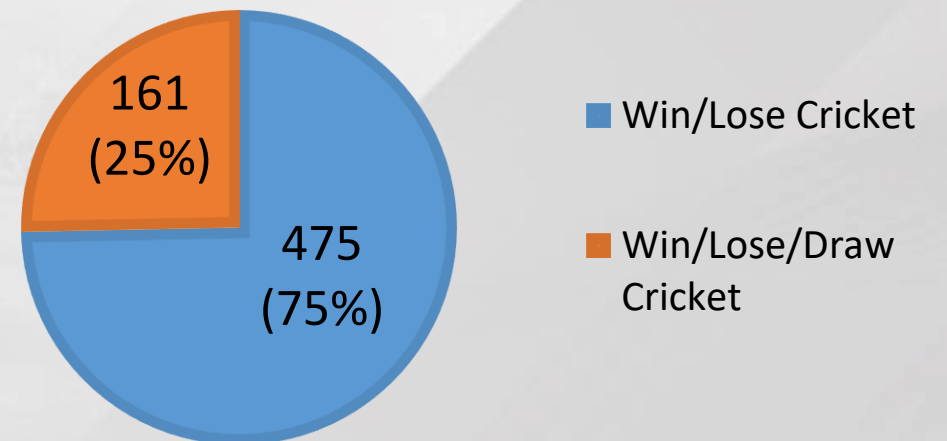
ALL PARTICIPANTS



PEOPLE OVER 40

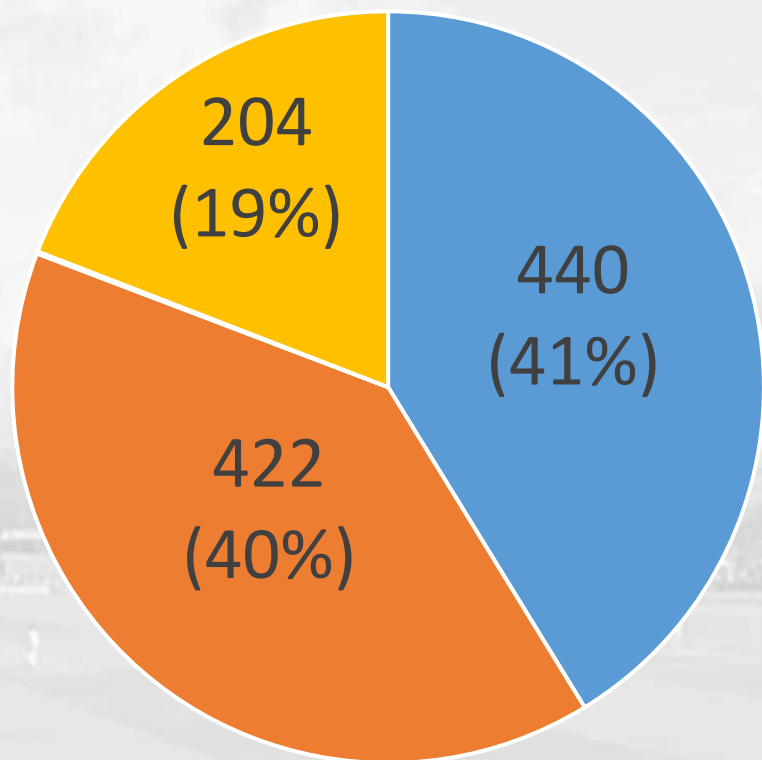


PEOPLE UNDER 40

Number of overs a bowler can bowl per game



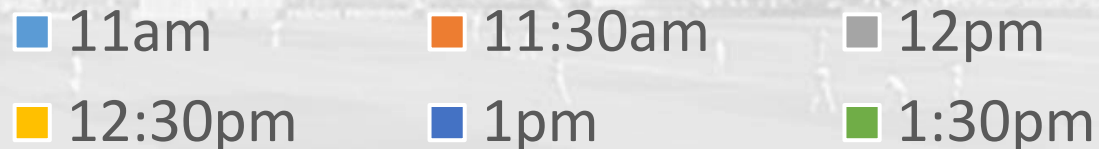
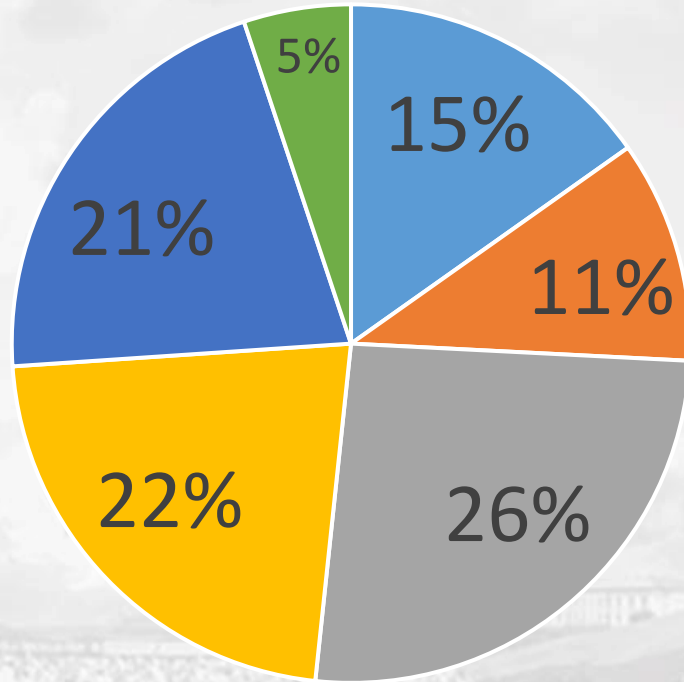
- 81% of participants want either 25% or 20% of overs

- Less than 1 in 5 want the 30% rules.

■ 30% of overs

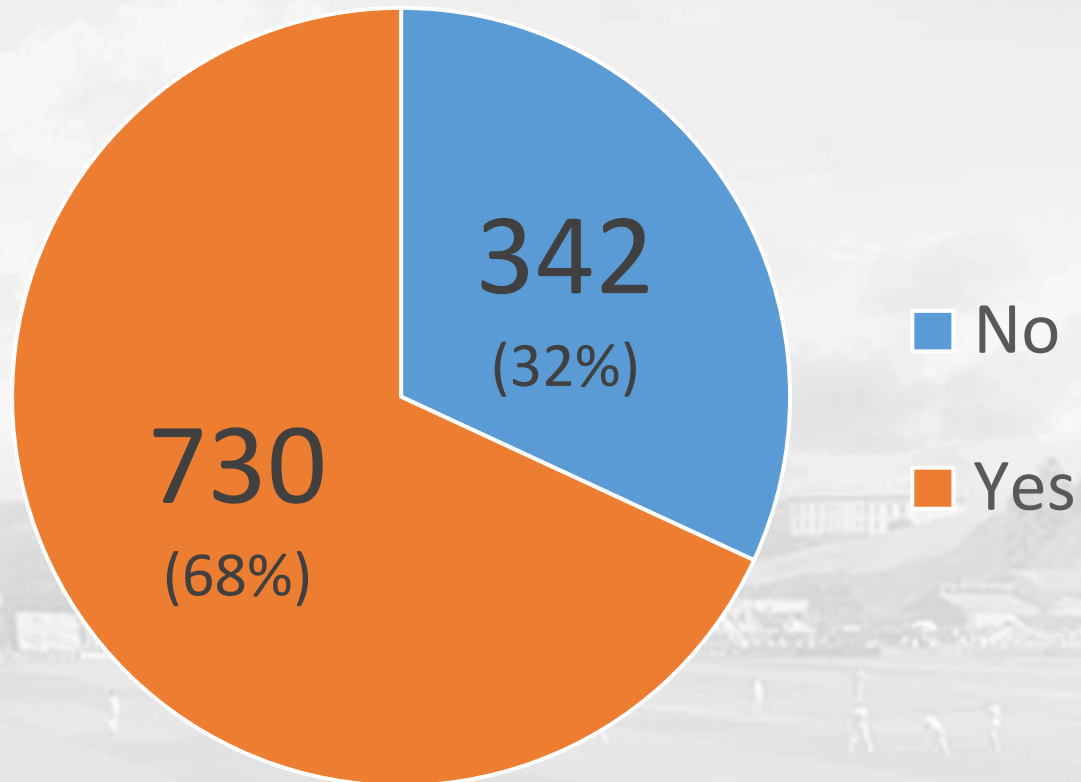
Preferred Start Time

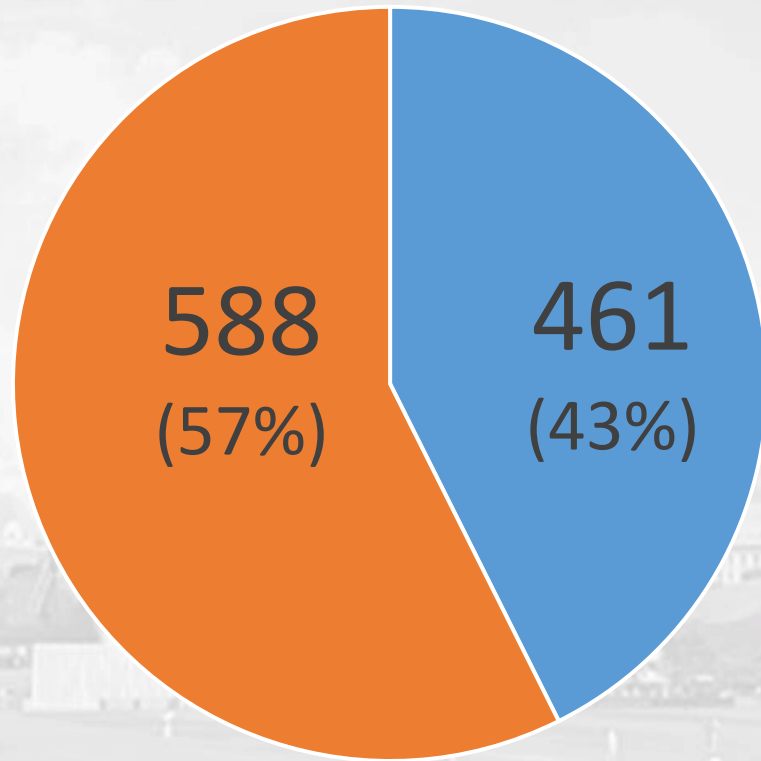
- 12pm most popular start time by votes
- Nearly 70% of those votes were for 12pm, 12:30pm or 1pm start
- 12:30 start would be option preferred by the most people
- Only 20% of votes were for AFTER 12:30pm

Should there be a development/friendly league



- The majority of the participants (68%) would like to see the introduction of development divisions or friendly league. With flexibility on arrangement of match days.
- DCF also think this would be welcomed as it would allow teams with a focus on development of juniors within senior cricket, to play against other teams of similar ability/focus
- E.g. A 4th XI made up of younger juniors playing against sides of similar make up. To avoid 1st XI's vs 4th XI's.
- A less of a focus on winning

Should there be 18 games or 22 games in a season?



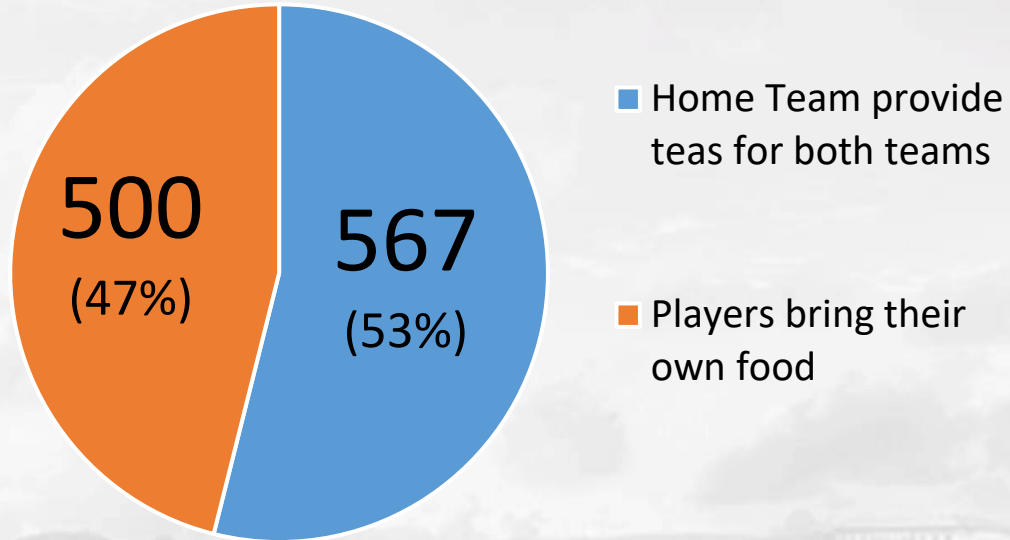
■ 18 games. Divisions of 10 teams

■ 22 games. Divisions of 12 teams

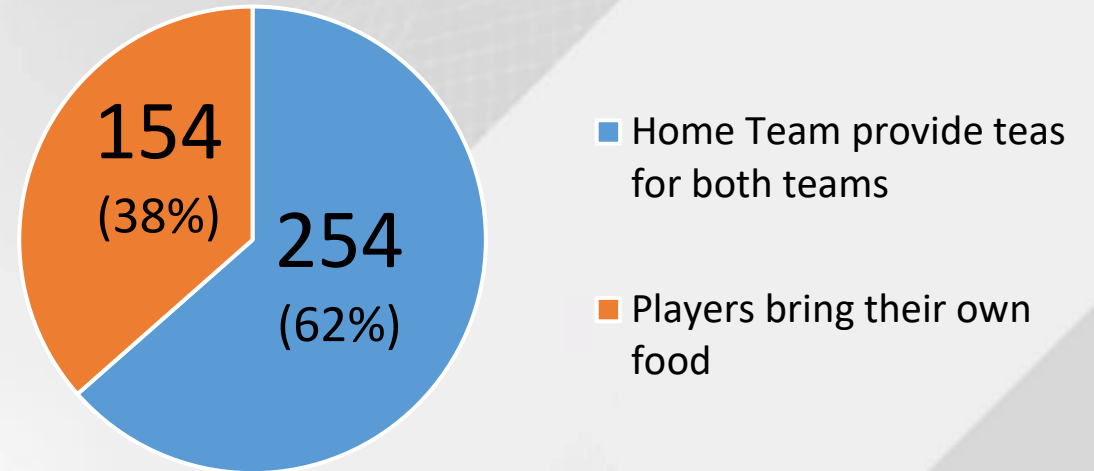
- Opinion is fairly split on this matter

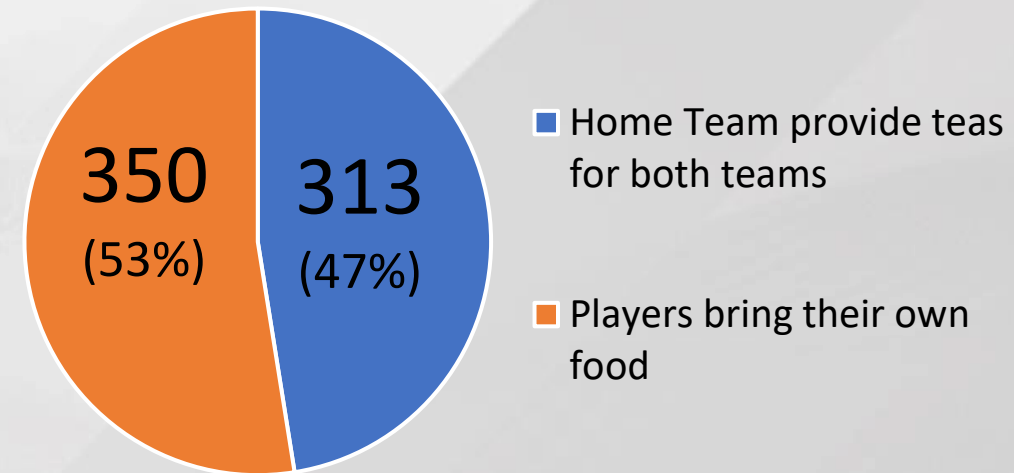
