Top Tips for starting your Women's or Girls Section

1. Use National Programmes effectively to create a girls team
2. Advertise/ Recruit Women to a taster session or social event at your club with a view to entering a team of 8 into a festival
3. Find the right person!
 - Engage with Junior parents and Junior Section (Face to Face)
 - Use any existing club members who are keen to help out in the short term
 - Advertise! Go public with the fact you are looking to start a Women or Girls team
 - People often don't know the club need help until you announce it!
 - Partners/ Wives of existing members
 - Other local sports clubs with Women's Sections e.g Rugby/ Hockey/ Football clubs

- 2 further inner city community centres didn't run. 64 south Asian children with a 50/50 split girls and boys.

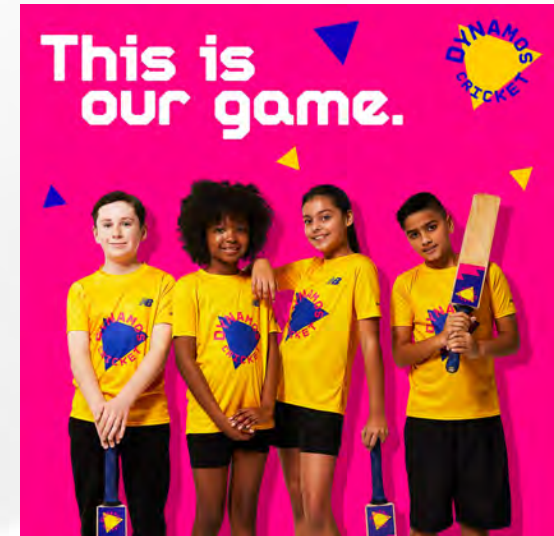

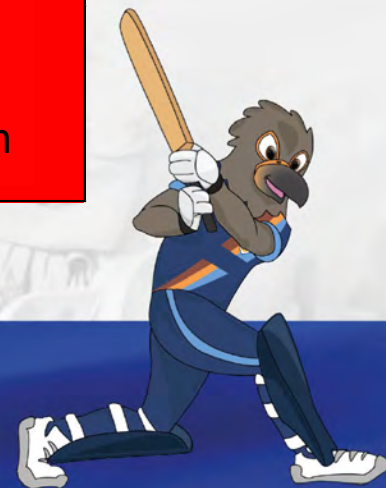

Development League

Pilot for 2021

Bridge the gap between junior and senior cricket

- End of May-September
- Primarily Sundays, flexibility to rearrange
- Teams to contain 6 players U21 or below
- Overs 25-40
- Bowlers to bowl no more than 25% of overs.
- Flexible start times
- 12 players. Only 11 bat.
- Fixtures and results on play cricket
- ACO to provide at least 1 umpire per game.

- 13 teams entered
- 44 fixtures planned
- 61% fixtures completed
