Women's Cricket


What formats are there to play in:

How does Women's Cricket Grow your volunteer base?

- 503 Women Played in our festivals from 51 clubs in 2022
- 29 clubs are entered into the East Midlands League
- In 2019, 27% of WSF Players took up a voluntary position at a club
- Average team has 12 new adults join as members huge!
- Total female coaches trained since October 2020 = 81
 - 45 Foundation Coaches, 3 Core Coaches, 33 Support Coaches











National Programmes

- What do you do in this space already?
 - 220 activators in Derbyshire in last two years
 - 42 females in 2022 62 centres
 - Demographic changing, increase in South Asian activators

Denby CC = 1 in 4 parents volunteered during the season

Belper Amateurs CC = 3 softball players now activators





Disability Champion Clubs

What is a Disability Champion Club?

Why will running this increase and diversify your volunteer base?

- Parents and carers are often required to support their child more within a session and are therefore more likely to help run the sessions alongside club coaches.
- If their child enjoys the sessions, parents and carers are much more likely to help out at the club because children with more severe disabilities are more likely to have fewer hobbies, clubs and sports they can take part in and enjoy. Parents and carers will likely be keen to ensure the club and the sessions can be successful and continue.
