The legal basis for processing your personal data	<p>The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • administration: that it is necessary to fulfil our obligation to you to investigate a concern; and/or that we have your consent; and/or that we have your explicit consent; and/or that it is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims • diversity and inclusion monitoring: that it is necessary for us to comply with the law or that it is necessary for the purposes of quality of opportunity • research, statistical analysis and benchmarking: that it is in our legitimate interests and those of other cricket organisations to analyse and assess statistics to understand and improve standards in cricket or that it is necessary for scientific or historical research or statistical purposes • safeguarding: that it is necessary to protect an individual from neglect or physical, mental or emotional harm or to protect their physical, mental or emotional well-being • in all other cases: that it is necessary for the purposes of measures designed to protect the integrity of sport and/or that it is necessary for our legitimate interests which are to regulate the sport of cricket, to uphold standards and ensure the reputation of cricket is enhanced and this does not prejudice or harm your rights and freedom and/or that it is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims

Your right to withdraw consent	Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it.
How we will store your personal data	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will keep your personal data within the United Kingdom.• We will normally keep your personal data for 2 years after the conclusion of our investigation into the concern raised or, 2 years after concluding any legal claim if this is longer. After this time period it will be anonymised and used for research and/or statistical analysis unless we are obligated to keep it by law.
Your rights in respect of your personal data	You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.
